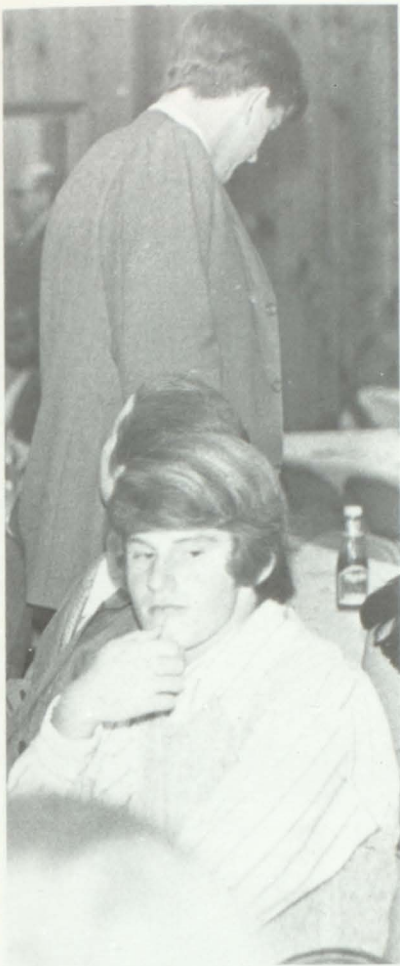


## *Be Festive!!*

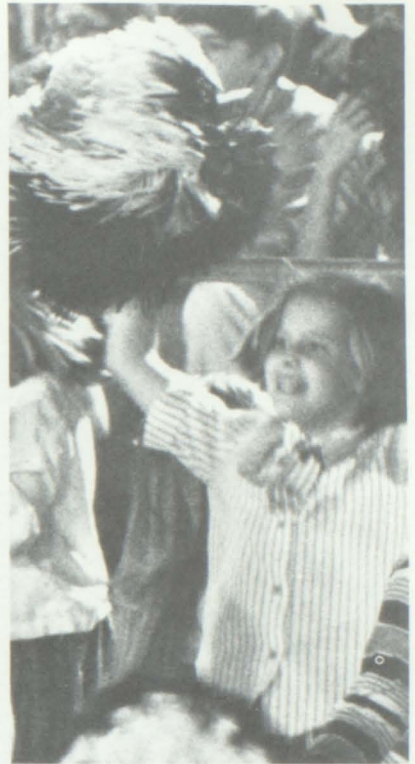


## *Be Excited!!!*
