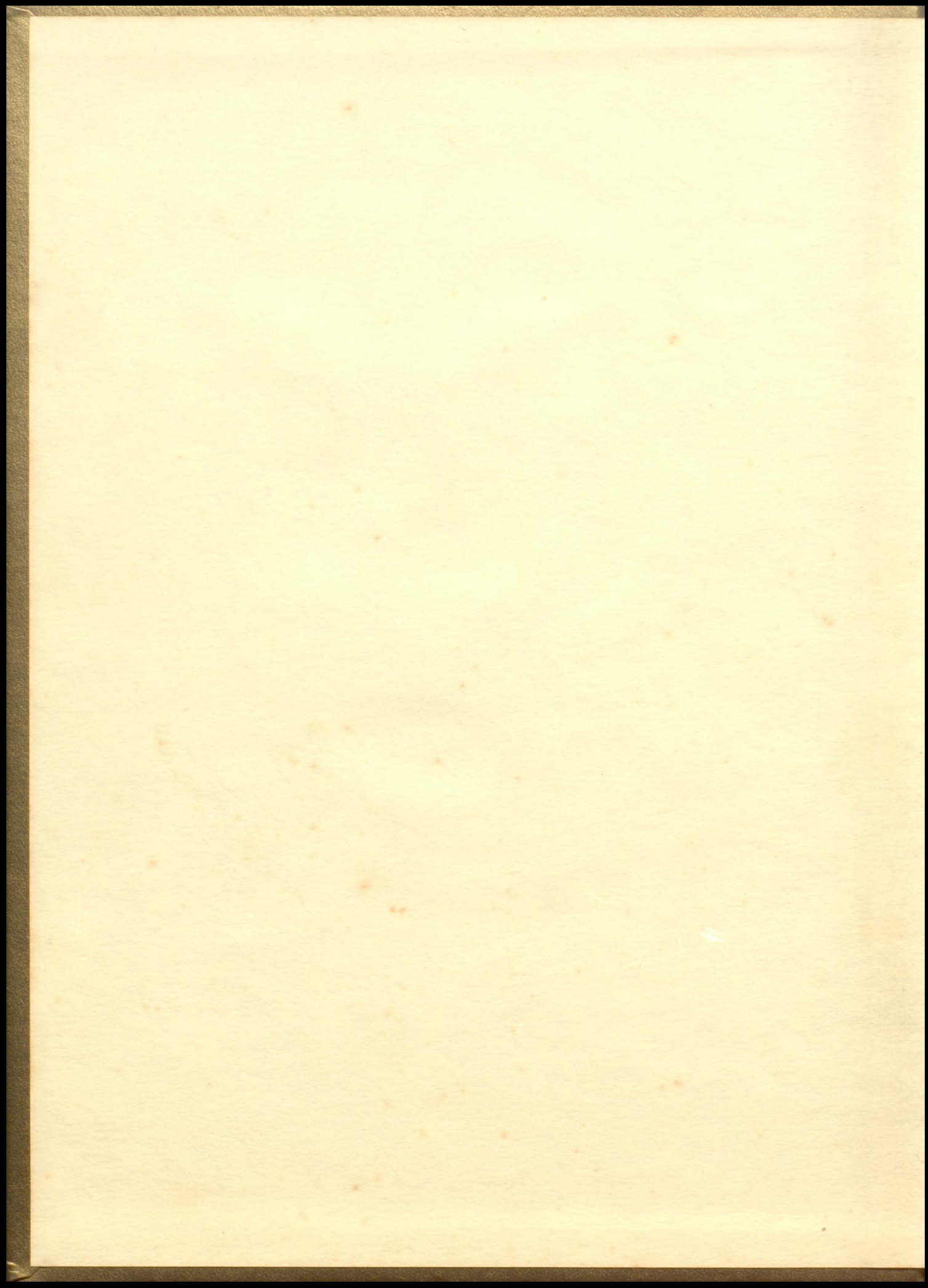
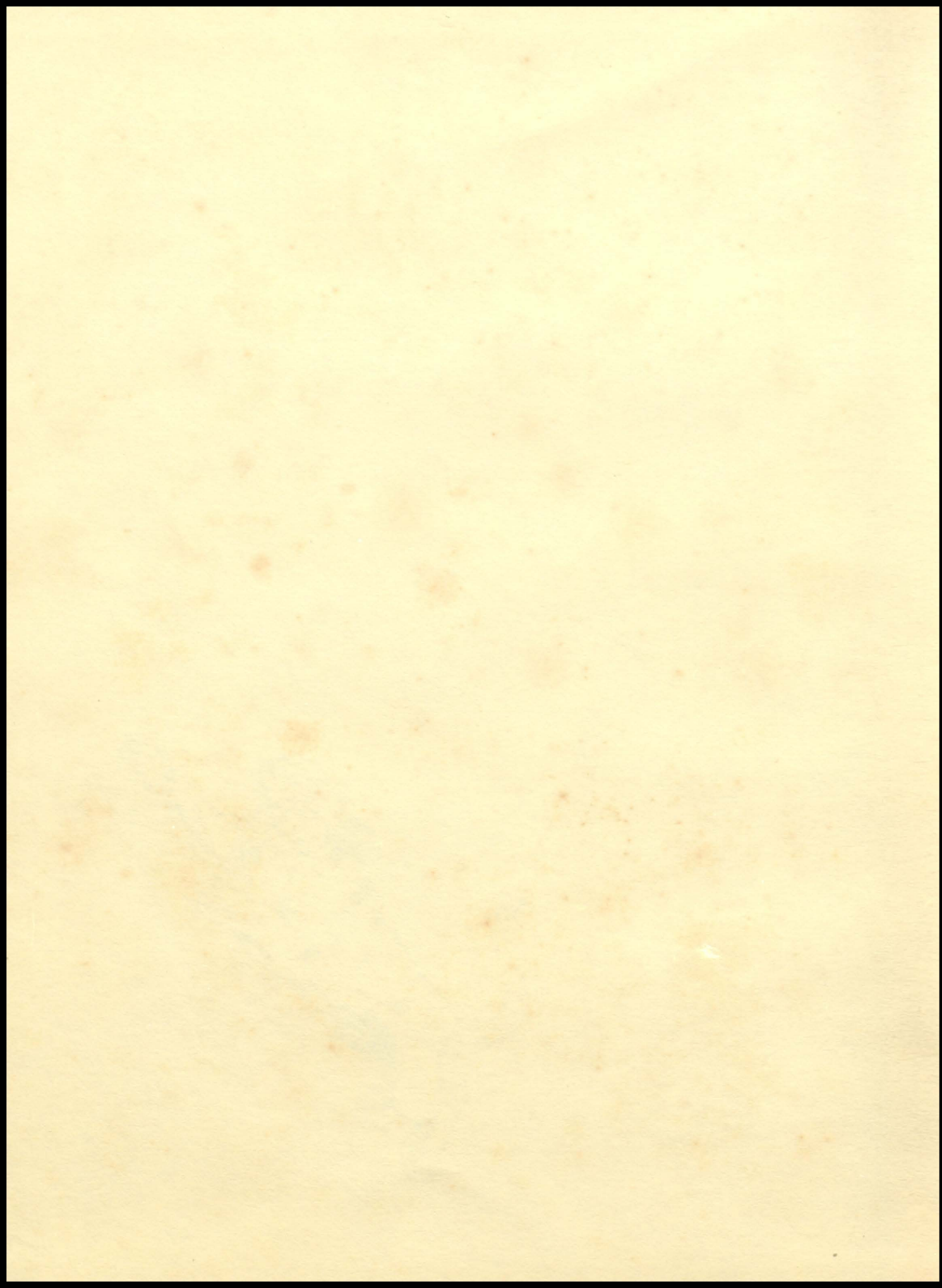

# DAVID UNDERWOOD BRYANT

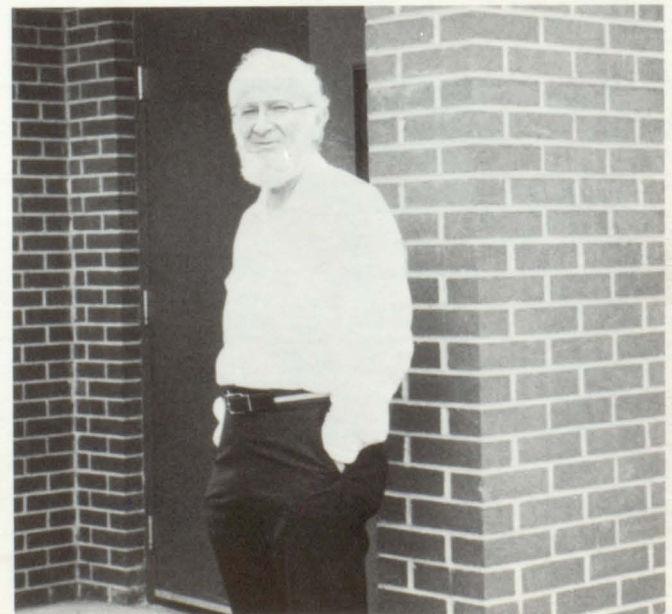
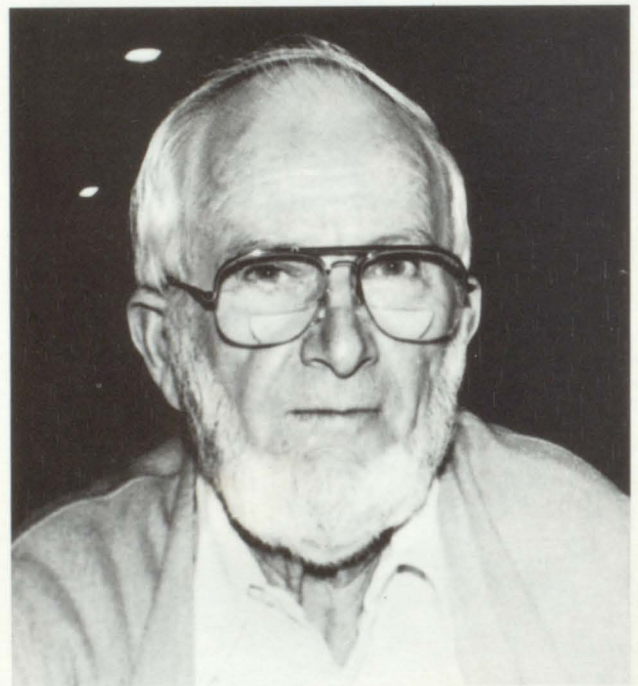

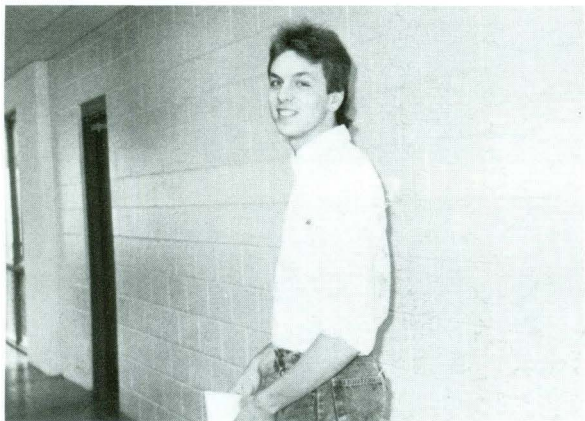


After the class of "85" has passed through its halls Pell City High will remain the same in many ways and will be changed in other ways.

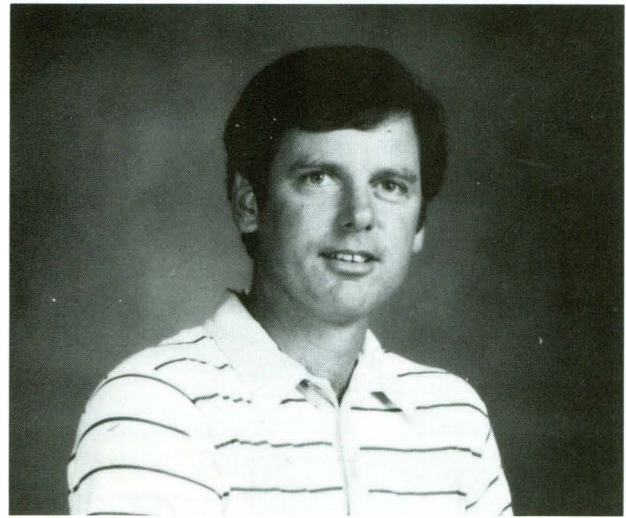
# 1985 FACULTY

## ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS

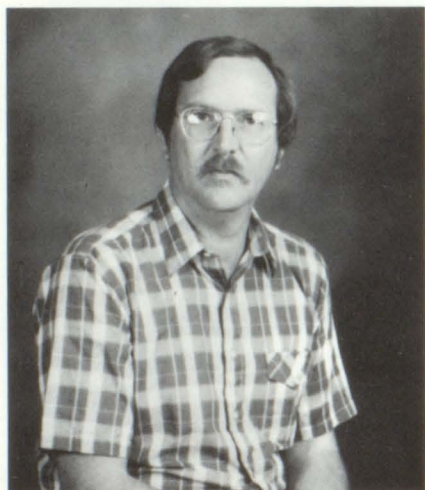

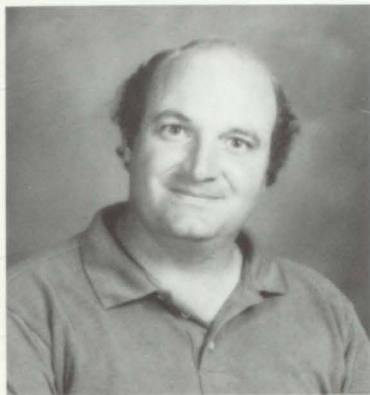
# SCIENCE

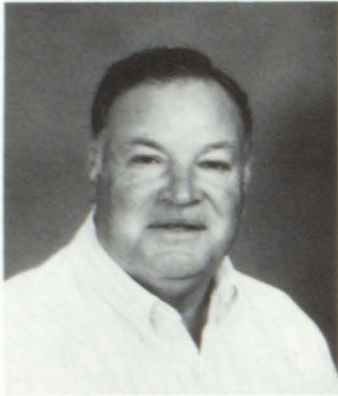

Science is important to everyone. Through science we have such things as the telephone, radio, and the television. What would the world be like without these things?

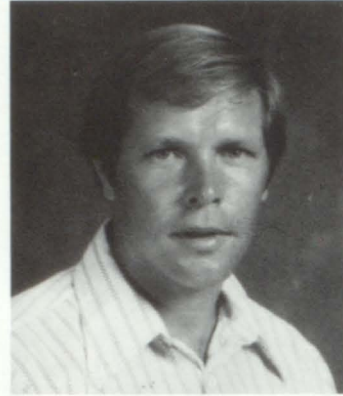
