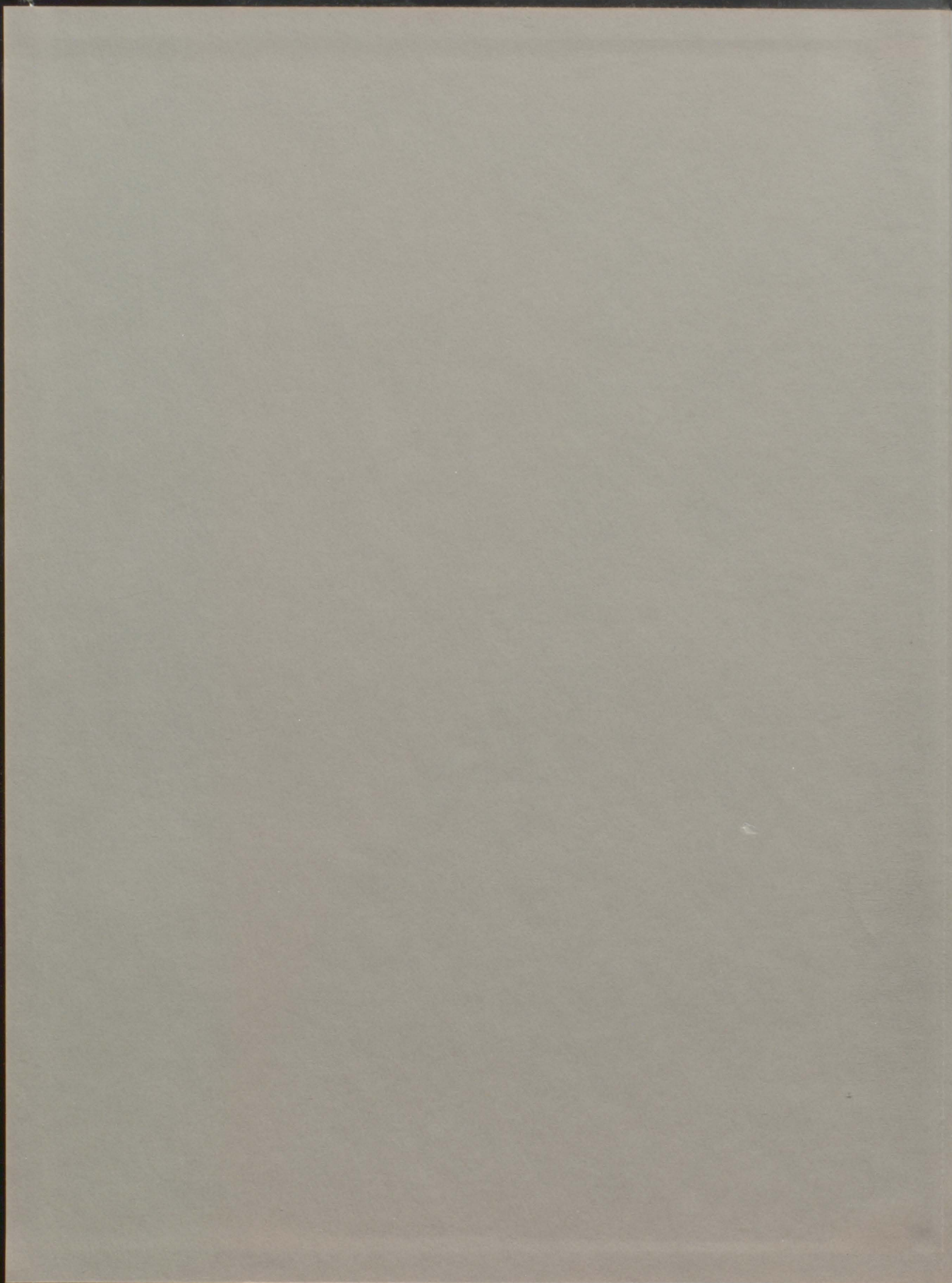


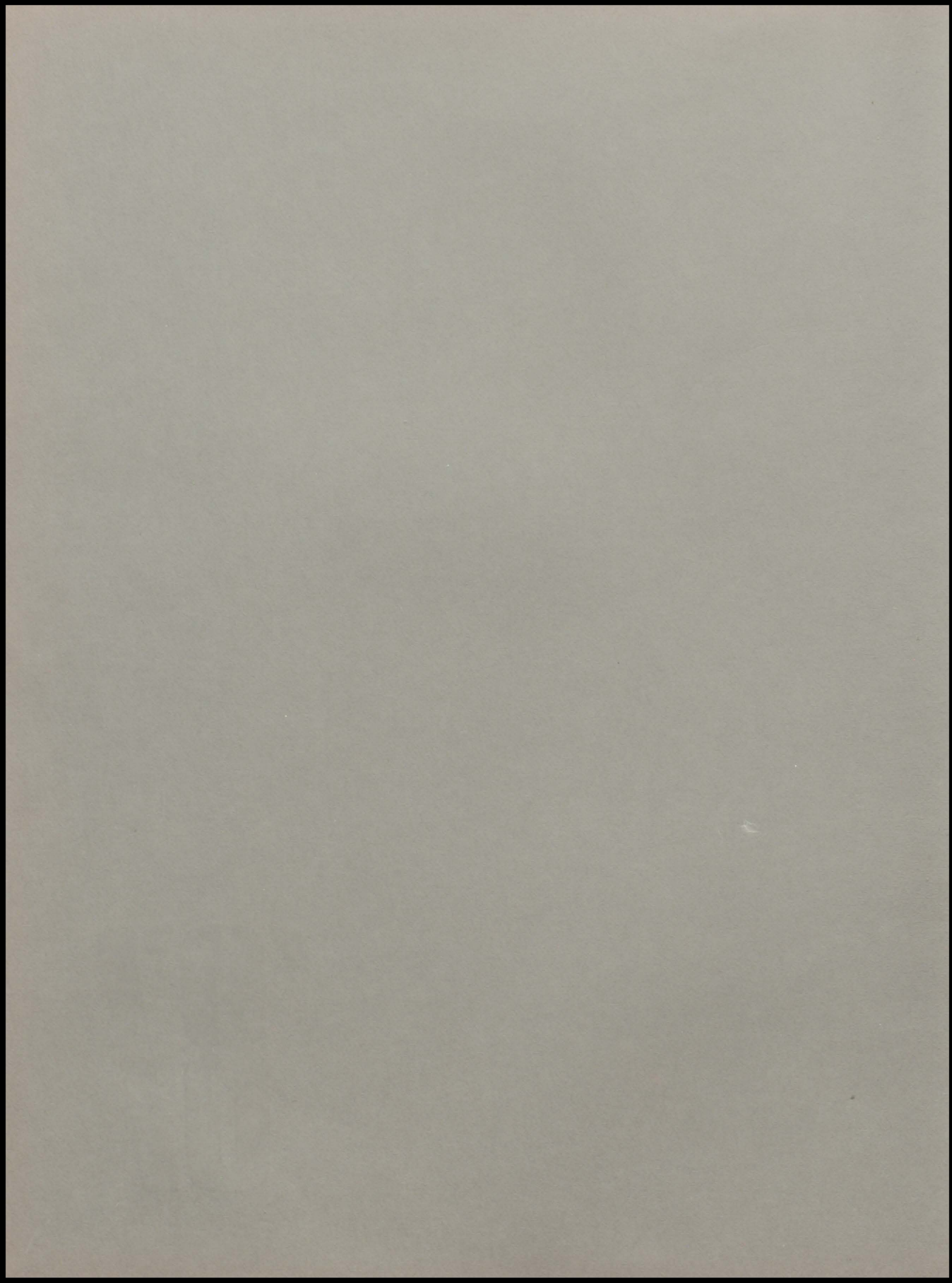

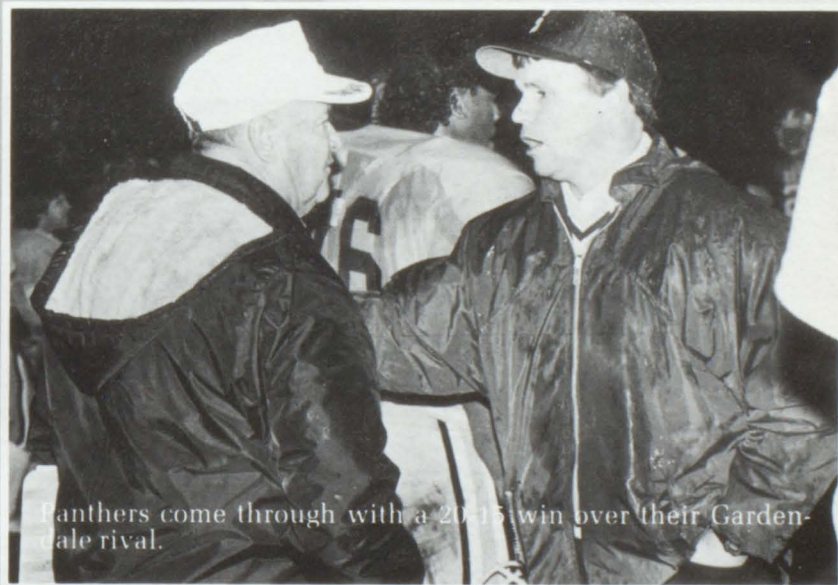
Coach Darnell enjoys fishing for crappie and bass. Needless to say, he also is an avid reader of sports magazines and sports pages in numerous newspapers.

# Style??

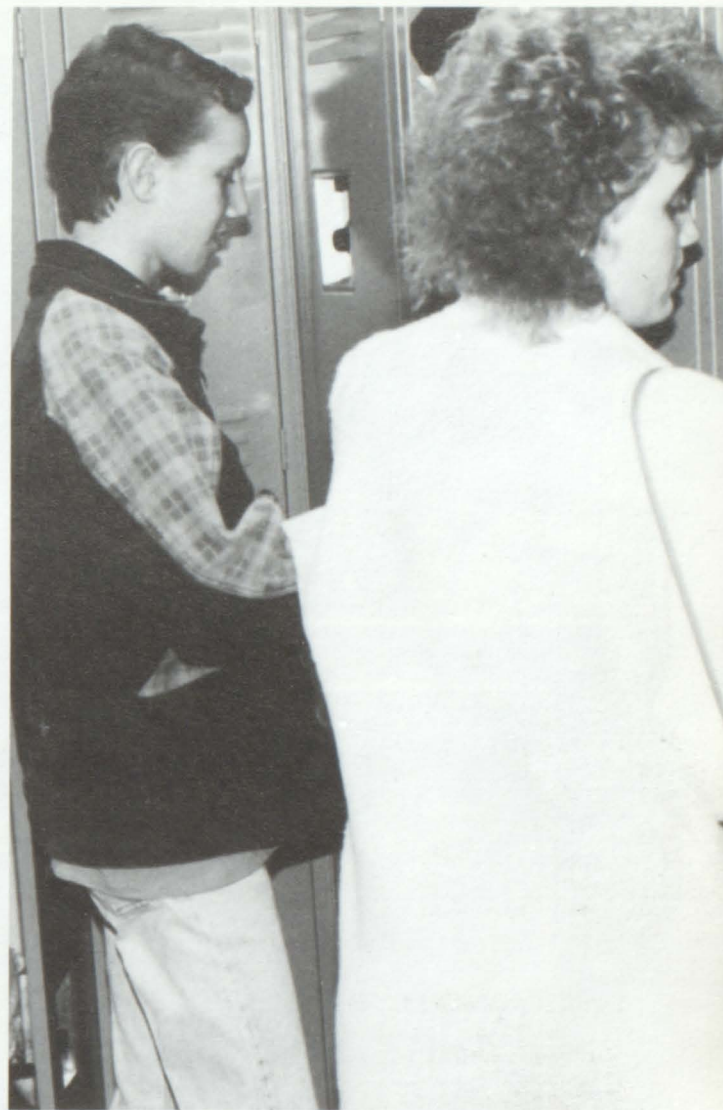

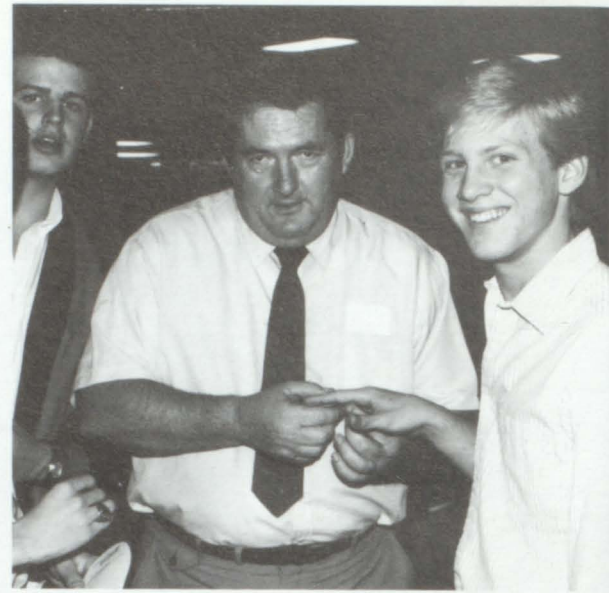






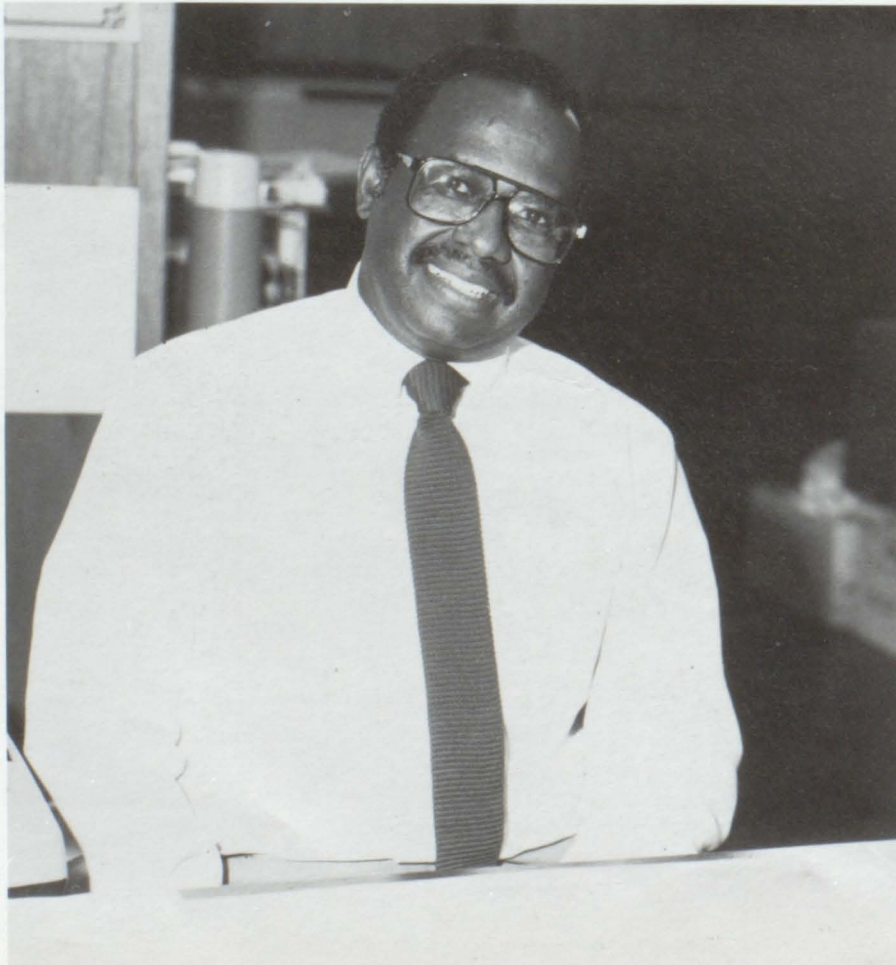

# PRINCIPAL



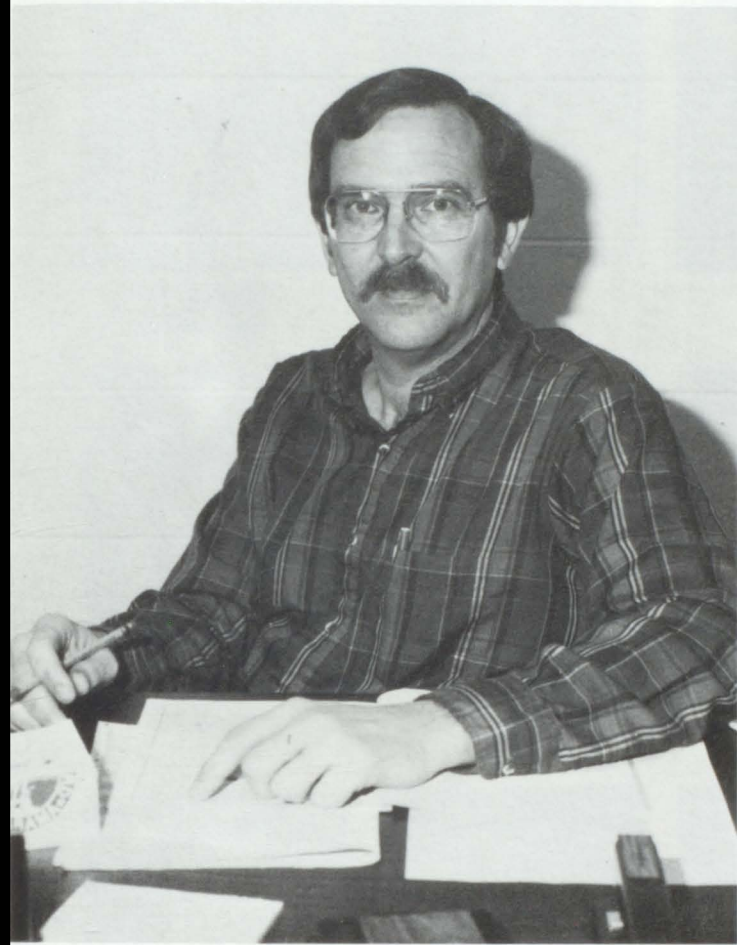
