Not in the case of those young ministers. No, no, that seems senseless; they were all set to help so many more, to do such much more good. But others? At least some others?

One thing is certain: A short life can be an intensely sweet one; almost always sweeter and purer than a life prolonged. Any parent who has lost a child acknowledges this. You sorrow for the joys of life that a child has missed, but you recognize the pain and problems it has been spared. It goes back to its maker unembittered, unscared, leaving only the most beautiful memories behind.

And we know — every instinct knows with some deep knowledge — that life does not stop, whatever its stage of interruption; it continues to develop in perfection. And usually far happier than it could possibly be in this precious but battle-wracked existence.

Quite a body of evidence is accumulating about the life experience beyond. Repeatedly, people who have been close to death, or who have actually died according to medical tests, who remember actually crossing over before being brought back by modern scientific technics, such people insist they experienced such joy, such imaginable peace and transport that they didn't want to return.


# PELL CITY








### **VOLLEYBALL TEAM SHINES WITH PRIDE**


