# PANTHER PRIDE



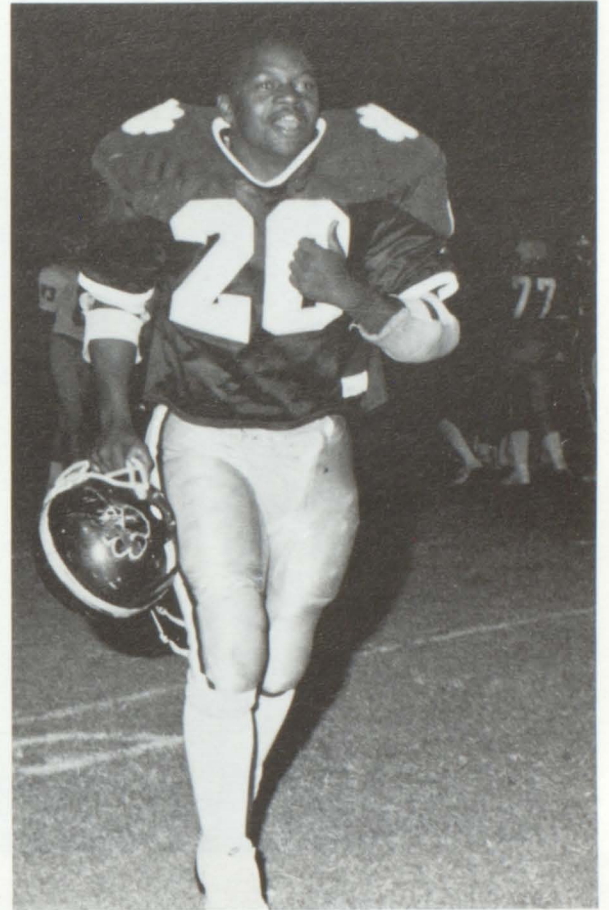

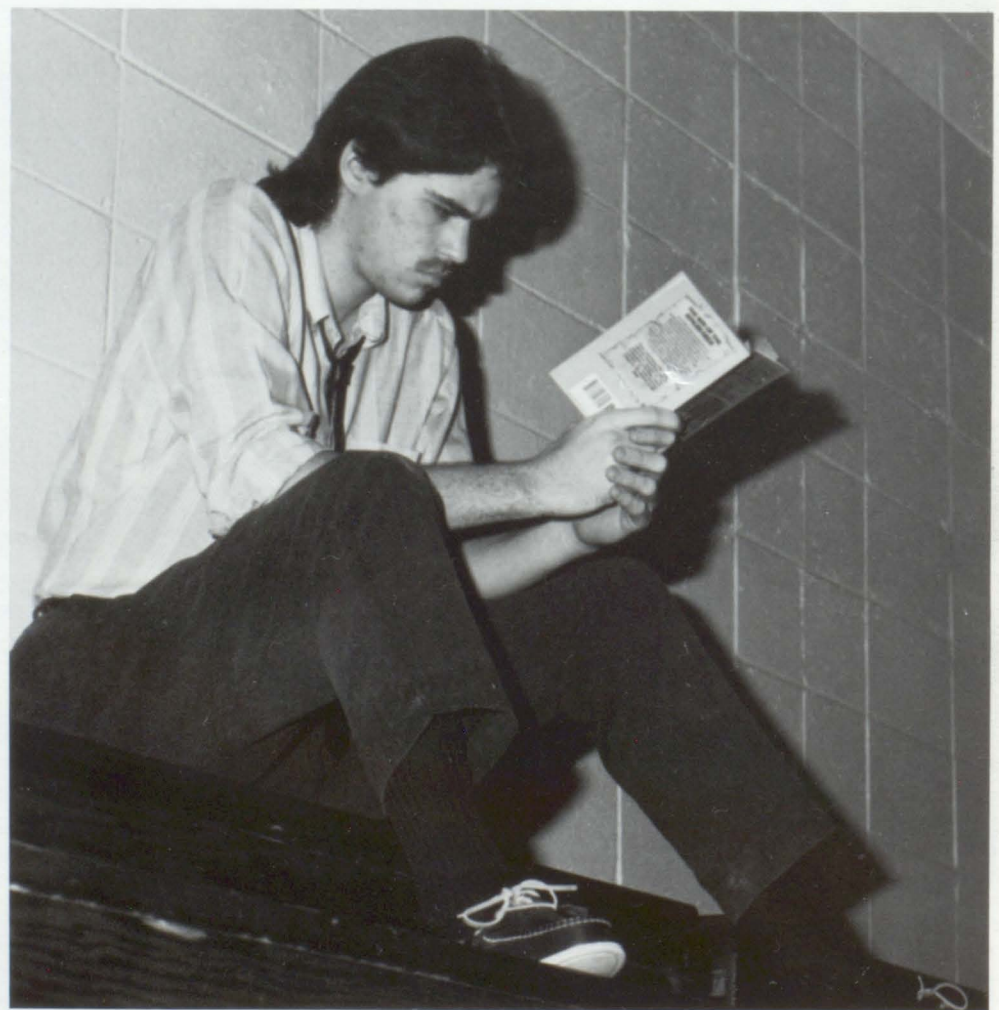

Kingdom of Dreams

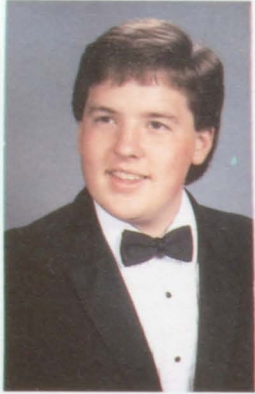
The time of youth has caught us.
