Woodworking is one of Sawyer's favorite hobbies. He built the cases which house his guns, several tables and two old picture frames hanging in his bedroom. The frames were made out of wood from an old barn that was torn down, Sawyer says, and he guesses that it is over 100 years old.

Sawyer admits that he is something of a handyman. While his wife designed and remodeled their home, he does all the plumbing and repair

He also enjoys scuba diving, and this hobby is not just for fun. He used to combine his mechanical skills and his

scuba diving to repair the piers at Riverside and Pine Harbor marinas.

Where does Joe Sawyer find the time to enjoy his hobbies, work on the City Council, and run a thriving dental practice? According to his wife, "Joe is motivated by a real concern for all people. He likes to keep busy and needs to feel useful."
