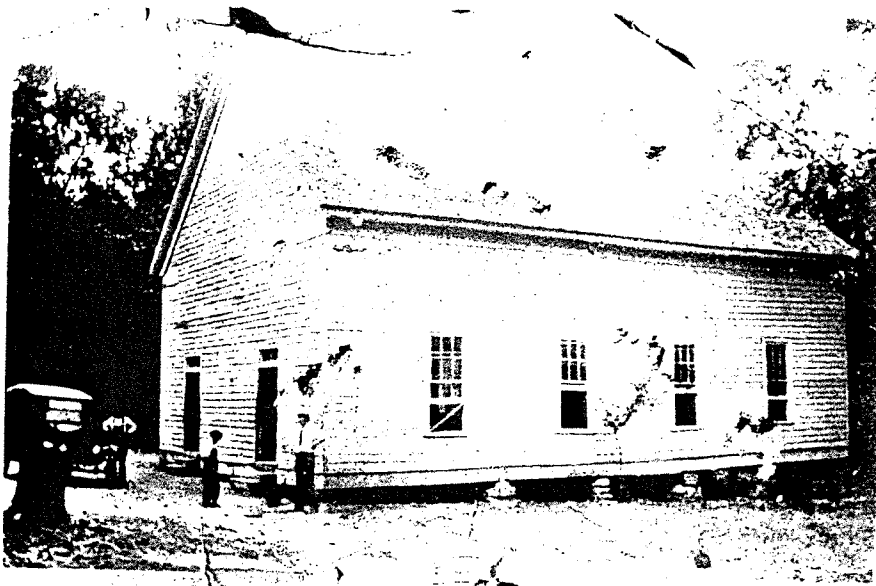

HISTORY OF COOL SPRINGS MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH

(This is a transcript of a talk given by Mrs. Bessie Whitfield Burttram during memorial day services on the 4th Sunday in May, 1969. The church celebrated its 100th anniversary that day.)

Sometime in the year 1869 a small church, known as Cool Springs Missionary Baptist Church, was organized at this place. We do not have a record of the church for 14 years, or from 1869 until 1883, but being a descendant of a charter member, my mind goes back to early childhood when my parents talked of the first church which was built of logs and was heated by a log burning fireplace. This building was located just to my left of the present church. The membership was small. We do not have a record of charter members other than John W. Ramsey who came from Ashville Baptist Church. He was a deacon, and the last charter member to die.

The church has survived many hardships in its time; but through the ages, leadership has been provided to carry on the work and much progress has been made. We wonder if the little band that made up the early church would recognize the present church as the same one that was founded 100 years ago. Over the years the grass roots of Cool Springs Baptist Church have reached far and deep. We shudder to think of what life would have been without its influence. Many have walked its aisles in sorrow and many have been made to rejoice. The church has met many needs, both spiritual and financial, and it has given courage to many that were ready to give up. All of these add up to the making of a stronger church. There has always been a tie of brotherly love that is so necessary for the ongoing and progress of a body of baptized believers which make the church.

It is with pride that I can say that I am the granddaughter of a charter member, the man who gave the land and helped to build the first church building, the late John Washington Ramsey.

Most of those who carried on the work are resting on the sunny slopes of the hills waiting for the second coming of our Lord. We can only pay tribute to their memory and enjoy the heritage they left us. But, the work must go on, and today we have the same offices of the church to be filled as in the early

church.

In addition to paying tribute to the memory of those gone on, I would like to pay tribute in person to those who carry the burden of the church now. You who do not come to Cool Springs often would probably like to know who carries the burden and responsibilities of the church now. They each have served the church in humility, and have given of their time unselfishly.

Things of Interest from the Church Records

In September 1884 the first recorded delegates to the association were elected. They were T. Scott, J.W. Davis, W.R. Anderson, and D.G. Teaver.

In August 1885 a nine day revival was held, with R.S. Sampler and A. Watson aiding the pastor.

In September 1886 the church paid to the state mission \$7.00 for that year.

In March 1887 H.J. Whitfield joined the church by letter. He was the first elected song leader of the church, being elected in April of 1887.

In October of 1887 the church recommended Rev. R.B. Devine to the Ministerial Education Board. He was later ordained to the ministry on July 29, 1888.

In May of 1889 we find the first recorded election of deacons. They were W.O. Moore, Albert Galbreath, and William Anderson. John W. Ramsey was also a deacon, but there is no record to show when he was ordained. It is possible that he was already a deacon when he came from Ashville Baptist Church.

In 1889 the first recorded church clerk was elected. He was G.T. Ramsey.

In January of 1890 the first recorded church treasurer was elected. He was S.T. Hess.

In January 1891 Bro. W. Johnson was endorsed to have a bill of lumber cut for the new church building. In March of 1891 a committee of five members was appointed to ascertain the indebtedness on the new church building and to assign to each male member his portion of the whole cost. The committee was composed of John W. Ramsey, Chairman; William Johnson, W.O. Moore, S.R. Vinyard, and James Vinyard. There is no record as to when they moved into this new church.

In 1892 Cool Springs Church was in the Cahawba Valley Association, but by 1901 the association had been changed to St. Clair Association.

In September 1893 a motion was carried to raise the pastor's salary to \$50.00 per year if ten men would sign their names to be responsible for that amount.

In April of 1895 a motion was carried that all those who wished to wash feet on Communion day could do so.

In October of 1898 W.I. Davis was elected church treasurer.

In July of 1899 permission was granted to use the church building as a school.

In May 1901 permission to put an organ in the church was refused, but it was later granted in 1902. Miss Ida Shew was the first elected organist (December 1902).

In December 1903 permission was asked and refused to have a Christmas tree in the church.

In 1906 the pastor's salary was raised to \$85.00 per year and a committee was appointed to solicit funds.

In December 1908 the first recorded Sunday school superintendent, B.L. Williams, was elected.

In February 1910, E.G. Shew, J.R. Alford and W.O. Moor were appointed to select a plot for the cemetery.

In January 1913 a motion was made to sell the old swinging lamps and apply the proceeds to the church treasury. In March of that same year, a motion was also made to sell the timber on the church lot. The church received \$13.58 for the

timber, and the money was later used to purchase seats for the church.

On May 6, 1922 the church voted to set up the 4th Sunday in May as annual memorial day.

On August 12, 1922 the church granted the school the privilege to build one of its "closets" on the church lot.

In June 1923 the church voted to hold weekly prayer meetings.

In November 1925 Bro. L.D. Galbreath made a statement to the church that he had planted and cultivated a plot of land for the Lord, and brought the money received to the church to be divided between the pastor and the orphans home.

In July 1936 arrangements were made with Alabama Power Company to install electricity in the church.

In October of 1936 George Williams was ordained to preach. He had been licensed by the church on September 2, 1934.

On November 22, 1936 the church voted to remodel the church building and add Sunday school rooms.

In August 1947 the first recorded Vacation Bible School was held. The principal was Mrs. Oscar Mitchell.

In December of 1948 repair work was begun on the church, and the asbestos siding was put on.

In March of 1955 the new pews were purchased and in April of 1956 the new communion table and pulpit were purchased.

In 1960 the well was drilled and water put in the church. By September 1961 the rest rooms were installed and the upstairs Sunday school rooms were finished.

A new piano and organ were purchased for the Church through the efforts of Mrs. Ila Boatwright and Miss Annie Whitfield.

In March of 1976 a baptistry was installed in the Church. A mural was painted behind the baptistry by Karl Scott, depicting the Creek and old baptising "hole" used by the Church for many years.

In January of 1977 pew cushions were added.

In December of 1981 the Church building was covered with white vinyl siding.

In April of 1984 Mrs. Marguerite Gaston donated 20 acres of land to the church for a pastorium site. A building fund for a pastorium was begun on June 3, 1984.

In January of 1987 a generous gift from the estate of Myrtle Teaver Carlisle was given to the Church and cemetery.

In September of 1987 a double-wide mobile home was purchased for use as a pastorium. The home was set up on the property donated for that purpose, and the pastor, Rev. James Maddox and family moved in on December 5, 1987.

In March of 1990 the Church kitchen was improved with new oak cabinets and quarry tile floors.

In November 1992 a section of the rock porch wall was removed and a ramp was built for handicap accessibility.
